- Be registered with SONB.

To be a Head Coach of a sport team you must:

- Provide a current Criminal Record Check to SONB
- Be registered with SONB

- Take our SO Competition Course – Introduction Workshop & NCCP Sport Specific Training
- Safe Sport Training – NCCP Locker

At the community level, it is not mandatory but highly recommended that our coaches take Making Ethical Decisions. These courses can be found on Coach.ca in the NCCP locker. Please check with SONB as we may cover the cost for you to take MED, Safe Sport is free.

At the competition level, it is mandatory that our coaches have both Making Ethical Decisions and Safe Sport.
